Introduction

This document provides the Scripture memory schedule for Covenant School for the 2010-2011 school year. Our theme for the year revolves around God's grace. Each month our Scripture memory will lead us to examine how Scripture (and all of God's revelation) equips us to better understand the depth of God's grace in the lives of followers of Christ. In addition to monthly Scripture memory, we also have longer passages of Scripture for the fall and spring. Our fall Scripture focuses on the birth of Christ and our spring Scripture comes from Titus. The fall Scripture is the same as last year's as our prayer is that our students will place God's Word deep in their hearts.

At Covenant we memorize Scripture as a community in order to encourage families to learn the Scripture together. We recognize that younger children may only memorize a portion of the passage. Each teacher will set expectations regarding the memory work for their class.

As a school we continually reinforce Scripture that has been previously memorized.

In addition to Scripture, we also formally memorize our school hymn, Amazing Grace. Additional hymns are memorized informally.

Theme

Our theme for the 2010-2011 school year is It's All About Grace from Ephesians 2:8-9:

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— 9 not by works, so that no one can boast.

School Hymn

Our school hymn is Amazing Grace. It is our goal to continue to memorize six verses of this hymn:

- 1 Amazing Grace! -how sweet the sound- that saved a wretch like me!
I once was lost, but now am found, was blind, but now, I see.
- 2 'Twas Grace that taught my heart to fear, and grace, my fears relieved;
how precious did that Grace appear the hour I first believed!
- 3 Thro' many dangers, toils and snares, we have already come;
'tis grace has brought me safe thus far, and grace will lead me home.

- 4 The Lord has promised good to me, his Word my hope secures;
he will my shield and portion be, as long as life endures.
- 5 And when this flesh and heart shall fail, and mortal life shall cease,
I shall possess within the veil a life of joy and peace.
- 6 When we've been there ten thousand years, bright shining as the sun,
we've no less days to sing God's praise than when we've first begun.

Scripture for Fall

Luke 2:8-14

- 8 And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night. 9 An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. 10 But the angel said to them, “Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. 11 Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord. 12 This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger.” 13 Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying, 14 “Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to men on whom his favor rests.”

August-It's All About Grace

Ephesians 2:8-9

September-Glorifying Grace

Romans 5:19-21

19 For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous. 20 The law was added so that the trespass might increase. But where sin increased, grace increased all the more, 21 so that, just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness to bring eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

October-Loving Grace

Ephesians 2:4-5

4 But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, 5 made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved.

Ephesians 4:1-2

1 As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. 2 Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.

November-Giving Grace

Romans 5:1-2a

- 1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, 2 through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand.

December-Redeeming Grace

John 1:14

- 14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Scripture for Spring

Titus 3:4-8

- 4 But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, 5 he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, 6 whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, 7 so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life. 8 This is a trustworthy saying. And I want you to stress these things, so that those who have trusted in God may be careful to devote themselves to doing what is good. These things are excellent and profitable for everyone.

January-Joyful Grace

Psalms 100

- 1 Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth.
2 Worship the LORD with gladness;
come before him with joyful songs.
3 Know that the LORD is God.
It is he who made us, and we are his
we are his people, the sheep of his pasture.
4 Enter his gates with thanksgiving
and his courts with praise;
give thanks to him and praise his name.
5 For the LORD is good and his love endures forever;
his faithfulness continues through all generations.

Hebrews 4:15-16

April-Strengthening Grace

2 Corinthians 12:9-10

- 9 But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. 10 That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

May-Unforgettable Grace

Titus 2:11-13

- 11 For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men. 12 It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age, 13 while we wait for the blessed hope—the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ.
