



Clothing Guidelines School Year 2010-2011

Covenant Christian School

Introduction

Covenant Christian School desires to create an atmosphere that encourages personal growth in Christian character and is conducive to learning. A factor that contributes to the atmosphere of the school is student dress. The experience of numerous schools has confirmed that standardized student dress presents several important advantages for school life. Examples of these advantages include reducing competition and peer fashion pressure, increasing mutual respect among students and promoting school spirit.

To this end, the school has adopted clothing guidelines for students in Little Pelicans through Kindergarten, and a school uniform for students in Grades 1 through 6.

Please note that all items purchased in the past with the Covenant School logo are “grandfathered in” and that you are welcome to send your student to school wearing these items. For example, some t-shirts with the Covenant logo that were a part of the uniform in past years are no longer available for purchase but may still be worn to school.

Special Days

The school administration, on occasion, will designate certain days as “special” and allow for exceptions to these clothing guidelines. Special days might include “Hat Day,” “Cardinals Day,” etc. The dates for our special days will be distributed to our families during the summer of 2010.

Guidelines for All Students

The following general clothing guidelines must be adhered to:

- Sweaters, sweater vests, or the official school sweatshirt only may be worn over collared shirts. White t-shirts only may be worn under collared shirts.
- All clothing should be in good repair (no frayed material).
- All shirts with tails must be tucked in.
- Girls wearing skirts or jumpers should wear modesty shorts underneath.
- Shorts are to be no more than 6" from the floor when the student is in a kneeling, upright position.
- Students must wear shoes or sandals with backs at all times (no flip flops or beach sandals).
- Hats are not to be worn inside the school.
- Visible temporary tattoos are not to be worn at any time by children grades 1 through 6.
- Body piercing is not permitted.
- Earrings are not permitted for boys.
- For girls, skirts, skorts, and jumpers are to be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.

- Hair should be neat and clean. Boys' hair is to be moderate in length and should not be longer than the shirt collar. Hair should not extend beyond the eyebrows in the front. Unusual hair styles which call attention to the individual will not be permitted. All hair must be of natural color for both boys and girls.

Guidelines for Little Pelicans, Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten

The main emphasis of the pre-school and Kindergarten wardrobe should be clothing that is neat, modest, and in good repair.

All Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten students must purchase a red t-shirt or collard shirt embroidered with the Covenant Christian School logo for field trips and special events.

Uniform for Girls Grades 1-6

All students must wear shirts purchased through Lands' End embroidered with the Covenant Christian School logo. For bottoms, the school has specified "uniform" style bottoms in navy or khaki while allowing the purchase of these items from a uniform supply provider such as Just Me Apparel. Please note that bottoms must be "uniform style."

All students 1st through 6th grade must purchase a red polo shirt embroidered with the Covenant Christian School logo for field trips and special events.

Shirts

- Mesh Polo: May be short or long-sleeve in red or white (also feminine fit)
- Interlock Polo: May be short sleeve or long sleeve in red or white (also feminine fit)
- Sweatshirt: May be red or gray heather.
- T- Shirt: May be short sleeve or long sleeve in red.
- Drifter Sweaters: May be crew, V-neck, vest or Cardigan in red or white.
- Oxford: Long-sleeve or short-sleeve in white.

Bottoms

All bottoms must be uniform khaki or navy twill. Girls may also wear plain navy jumpers (not knit).

Girls may wear:

- pants
- skirts
- skorts
- shorts
- capris
- jumpers

Uniform for Boys Grades 1-6

All students must wear shirts purchased through Lands' End embroidered with the Covenant Christian School logo. For bottoms, the school has specified "uniform" style bottoms in navy or khaki while allowing the purchase of these items from any supplier. Please note that bottoms must be "uniform style."

All students 1st through 6th grade must purchase a red polo shirt embroidered with the Covenant Christian School logo for field trips and special events.

Shirts

- Mesh Polo: May be short sleeve or long sleeve in red or white
- Interlock Polo: May be short sleeve or long sleeve in red or white
- Sweatshirt: May be red or gray heather.
- T- Shirt: May be short sleeve or long sleeve in red.
- Drifter Sweaters: May be crew, V-neck, vest or Cardigan in red or white.
- Oxford: Long-sleeve or short-sleeve.

Bottoms

All bottoms must be uniform style khaki or navy. Boys may wear pants or shorts. No cargo pants allowed.

Ordering Information

All uniform shirts must be purchased through Lands' End. Uniform bottoms may be purchased through any uniform provider such as Lands' End or Just Me Apparel.
